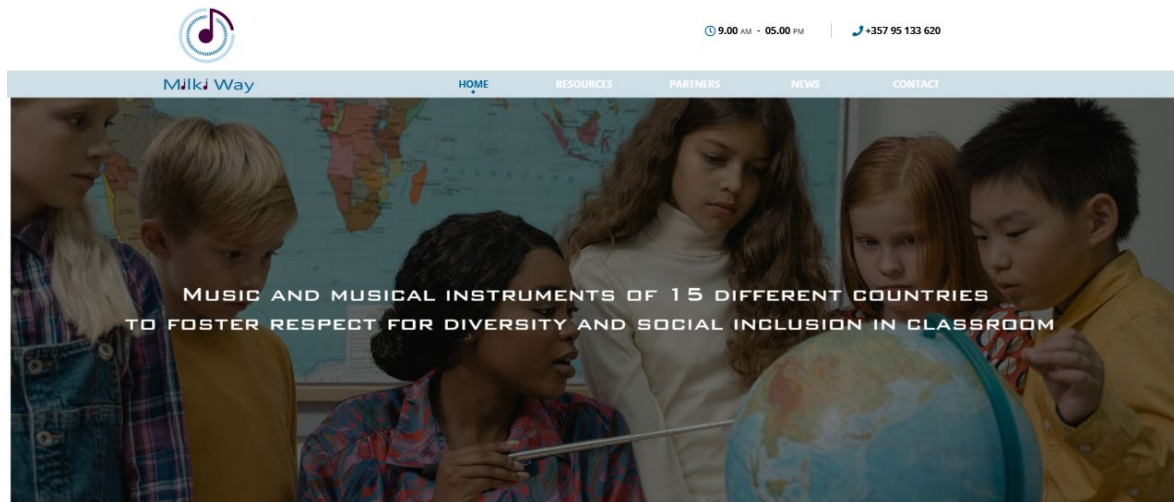

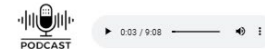
MILKI-WAY- Music Instrument e-Library for Kids Way of multicultural enjoyment and learning.
